



Youth Heritage Outdoors Hosts and Announces Results of First-Ever Legacy Tournament

Minnesota based Youth Heritage Outdoors (YHO) is proud to announce the results of the **world's first ever** youth bass fishing and trapshooting combination tournament!

August 1, 2025

On June 27-28, 2025, Minnesota teams in both the high school and middle school ranks competed in the world's first ever combined youth bass fishing and trapshooting tournament known as "The Legacy." Organized and hosted by Youth Heritage Outdoors, this two-day event put competitors to the test by challenging their bass fishing skills against their trapshooting skills. The scoring system combines placements and points earned during each discipline. To win this event, youth would need to have solid performances in both disciplines.

The Results

In its inaugural year, the Legacy Tournament hosted six teams representing 12 students from four high school teams and two middle school teams. Congratulations go out to Korin Kostreba and Devon Engebretson of Holdingford High School in Minnesota for winning the high school division with a score of 198/200! They placed runner up in both bass fishing and trapshooting disciplines, proving to be the best at their craft for this two-day event. Overall second place in the high school division required a shoot-off tie breaker.

The successes didn't stop there as Kaleb Palmersheim and Luke Hulst of Kasson-Mantorville won the middle school division! Leading after day 1 but trailing on day 2, the team of Hulst and Palmersheim quickly realized a shoot-off tie breaker was going to determine the winner. The team from Kason-Mantorville prevailed by winning the high pressure tie-breaker.

The Legacy Tournament also hosted two bonus games during the event, namely a 27-yard trapshooting competition and an Annie Oakley competition. Olin Nelson from Wayzata High School prevailed in the 27-yard after edging Korin Kostreba in a tie-breaker shoot-off. Korin Kostreba took home additional honors by winning the Annie Oakley competition.

YHO awarded scholarships to the 1st and 2nd place teams in the high school division, and fishing and trapshooting prizes to the winners of the middle school division and bonus games.

High school winners Korin and Devon were interviewed after the event. When asked what her favorite part of the event was, Korin said: *“Honestly, I loved everything about it. I really enjoyed the games and the additional chance to win prizes. I thought it was very well run. Great atmosphere to meet new kids.”* Regarding the prizes and awards, Devon shared: *“I thought they were outstanding! It was so cool to get a \$50 Scheels gift card just for registering.”*
